Life Unlimited—Hearing Therapy Service

Hearing Therapy is a free and independent national service offering free hearing tests, and information about hearing aid management and other assistive listening devices, such as amplified telephones and smoke alarms, and advice about funding.

Although funding for smoke alarms is limited for those under the age of 16, we can talk to families about the types of alert systems available if they are interested in installing them in their home.





Hearing therapists work with other health professionals and service providers to find the best outcomes for families affected by hearing impairment. There are 4 therapists in Auckland, delivering clinics in Royal Oak, Glen Innes, Orewa, Albany and Henderson.
